



Laptop Guidance

As the importance of online information and communication continues to grow, we are committed to ensuring our pupils are well-placed to meet the ever-increasing demands of the future.

All pupils should arrive at school with their own device to allow them to work in their houses and also to enable them to have access to online information in class. All devices should be clearly identified with pupils' names.

The College operates a "Bring Your Own Device" policy and pupils are expected to attend school with an unrestricted WiFi enabled device. Details below:

- Chromebooks, laptops and Macbooks are suitable.
- Devices must have up-to-date Antivirus protection
- No specific software or memory requirements.
- A case to protect the laptop is recommended.
- Devices should be free from parental controls/VPN tunnels to operate on the College's WiFi.
